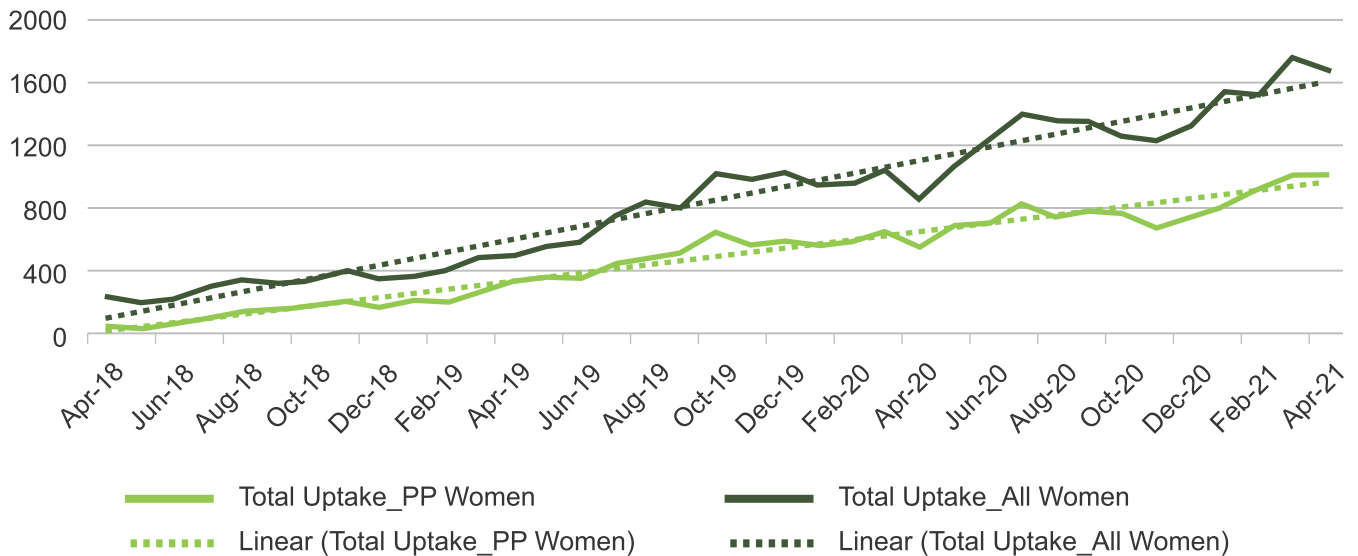




# The Post Pregnancy Family Planning project

Intervention across **236** private health facilities in Lagos State - 2017 to 2021

Contraceptive uptake among women across supported facilities April 2018 - April 2021



## Family planning service (counselling and uptake)

**4,653**

modern contraceptive uptake before PPFP intervention

**31,621**

modern contraceptive uptake at endline after PPFP intervention  
58% of these women were post pregnancy clients

**43,385**

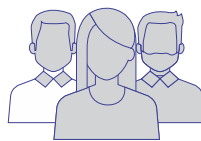
women accessed family planning (counselling) service at PPFP supported facilities by endline.

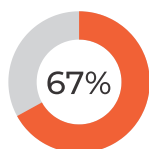

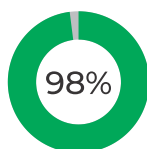

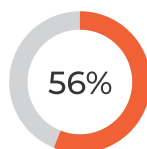

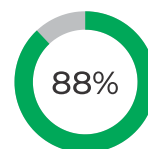
women satisfied/very satisfied with service received at **Baseline**



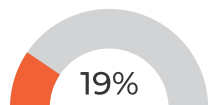
women satisfied/very satisfied with service received at **Endline**



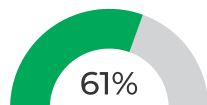
women who knew they could obtain FP at the facility **Baseline**



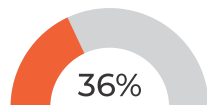
women who knew they could obtain FP at the facility **Endline**



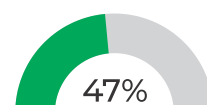
women who received FP information when receiving other services at **Baseline**
